GIFFORD GOLF CLUB JUNIOR OPEN 2010

Conditions of Competition

1. Open to all male and female golfers who are under 18 years of age on 1st January in the calendar year of the event, and who hold a current CONGU® handicap.
2. Application shall be in writing, accompanied by the specified non-refundable entry fee.
3. Times shall be allocated on a first-come basis, and a SAE should be enclosed for confirmation.
4. Competitors must register at least 15 minutes prior to play. Handicap certificates are required.
5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the current Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and any additional Local Rules as laid down by Gifford Golf Club.
6. 18 holes of stroke play using full handicap allowance shall be played. Boys shall play from the White Medal Tees and girls from the Red Medal Tees. Play shall be in groups of three, unless otherwise authorised by the Committee.
7. Prizes shall be awarded in various categories. Ties shall be decided by card count-back over the last 9, 6, 3, or 1 hole(s) using appropriate handicap fractions; if there is still a tie for 1st place, the trophy will be shared.
8. Handicap prizes shall take precedence over scratch prizes and no competitor may win more than one prize.
9. Competitors shall walk at all times during the competition unless permitted to use transportation by the Committee, as provided for in terms of the Club Transportation Policy.
1. Devices that measure **distance only** shall be permitted.
2. Competitors may not have a relative as a caddie. Penalty for breach – Disqualification.
3. In the event of dangerous weather conditions, Rule 6-8, Rules of Golf (pages 58-60) applies.
4. If the competition requires to be abandoned, no prizes will be awarded.
5. The Committee reserves the right to amend start times if necessary, and in all other matters its decision will be final.
