GIFFORD GOLF CLUB OPEN MIXED FOURSOMES 2010

Conditions of Competition

1. Open to all male and female golfers who hold a current CONGU® handicap.
2. Application shall be in writing, accompanied by the specified non-refundable entry fee.
3. Times shall be allocated on a first-come basis, and a SAE should be enclosed for confirmation.
4. Competitors must register at least 15 minutes prior to play. Handicap certificates are required.
5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the current Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and any additional Local Rules as laid down by Gifford Golf Club.
6. 18 holes of Foursome stroke play shall be played. Gents shall play from the White Medal Tees and Ladies shall play from the Red Medal Tees. Ladies shall tee off at the 1st hole.
7. Both handicaps must be shown on the scorecard. Handicap allowance shall be half the combined handicaps and half strokes are counted as such.
8. Ties shall be decided by card count-back over the last 9, 6, 3, or 1 hole(s), using appropriate handicap fractions; if there is still a tie for 1st place, the trophy will be shared.
9. Handicap prizes shall take precedence over scratch prizes. No partnership may win more than one prize, excluding smaller prizes such as 'nearest the hole'.
10. Competitors shall walk at all times during the competition unless permitted to use transportation by the Committee, as provided for in terms of the Club Transportation Policy.
11. Devices that measure **distance only** shall be permitted.
12. In the event of dangerous weather conditions, Rule 6-8, Rules of Golf (pages 58-60) applies.
13. If the competition requires to be abandoned, no prizes will be awarded.
14. If the money from any '2's sweep is not awarded, it will be donated to charity.
15. The Committee reserves the right to amend start times if necessary, and in all other matters its decision will be final.
