Conditions of Competition

1. Open to all female golfers aged 55 or over and who hold a current CONGU® handicap.
2. Application shall be in writing, accompanied by the specified non-refundable entry fee.
3. Times shall be allocated on a first come basis, and a SAE should be enclosed for confirmation.
4. Competitors must register at least 15 minutes prior to play.
5. Handicap certificates are required.
6. The competition shall be played in accordance with the current Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and any additional Local Rules as laid down by Gifford Golf Club.
7. 18 holes of Greensome Stableford stroke play shall be played from the Red Medal Tees.
8. Both handicaps must be shown on the scorecard. Handicaps shall then be adjusted to Greensome allowances as recommended by CONGU®.
9. Ties shall be decided by card count back on points gained over the last 9, 6, 3, or 1 hole(s).
10. Competitors shall walk at all times during the competition unless permitted to use transportation by the Committee, as provided for in terms of the Club Transportation Policy.
11. Distance-Measuring devices shall not be permitted.
12. Scorecards shall be allocated by the starter, who will advise on where to return completed cards.
13. In the event of dangerous weather conditions, Rule 6-8, Rules of Golf (pages 58-60) applies.
14. If the competition requires to be abandoned, and cannot be re-arranged, no prizes will be awarded unless more than 75% of the players have completed their round.
15. The money collected from any '2's sweep will be donated to charity if no-one has a '2'.
16. The Committee reserve the right to amend start times if necessary, and in all other matters their decision will be final.
