Terms of Competition

1. Open to all female golfers aged 70 or over and who hold a current CONGU® handicap or EGA/USGA equivalent.
2. Application shall be in writing, accompanied by the specified entry fee.
3. Times shall be allocated on a first-come basis, and notified by email or a SAE should be enclosed for confirmation.
4. Competitors must register at least 15 minutes prior to play.
5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the current Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and any additional Local Rules as laid down by Gifford Golf Club.
6. 9 holes of Stableford stroke play shall be played from the Red Medal Tees.
7. Scores will **not** count for handicap purposes.
8. Ties shall be decided by card count-back on points gained over the last 6, 3, or 1 hole(s); if there is still a tie for 1st place, prizes will be shared.
9. Competitors shall walk at all times during the competition unless permitted to use transportation by the Committee, as provided for in terms of the Club Transportation Policy.
10. Distance- Measuring devices are permitted.
11. In the event of dangerous weather conditions, play may be suspended by sounding a horn.
12. If the competition requires to be abandoned, no prizes will be awarded.
13. If the money from any sweep is not awarded, it will go to a charity.
14. The Committee reserves the right to amend start times if necessary, and in all other matters its decision will be final.
