



GENTS WINTER ECLECTIC COMPETITION (2025/26)

COMPETITION RULES

- The final competition placings will be based on 50% of course handicap (net eclectic) at the end of the series. There will also be a 'gross' winner (gross eclectic).
- Once general play is suspended for the winter, typically at some point during January to March, the individual competitions will be non-qualifiers for handicap.
- On days when winter greens are in use scores should NOT be entered for the eclectic. The individual competition will still run as normal but will be non-counting for the eclectic and non-qualifying for handicap.
- Players must attempt to complete every hole regardless of any previous better eclectic score.
- Holes must be played in the correct order. For example, if you only need to improve your score on the 15th, it is not permitted to go straight to the 6th tee, call it the 15th, and play just that hole. You must have played 1 to 14 first.
- Any card with an NR will be disqualified from that day's competition placings. However, the card is still valid for any 2s sweep and completed hole score will still count towards the eclectic.
- Members are reminded when entering scores in the clubhouse terminal to tick the box to include the score in the eclectic competition.
