# GIFFORD GOLF CLUB LADIES' OPEN CHARITY TRI-AM 2021

## Terms of Competition

**COVID – as at 26/4/21 our Clubhouse is only open from 8.30am – 2.30pm with space limitations. On the day of the Open, toilets will be available throughout. If travel is restricted and golfers cannot come to Gifford, are not allowed to play in 3's or the toilets cannot be available, the following will be offered - a full refund, carry the entry fee to 2022 or donate the entry fee to the Charity.**

**The Charity that Gifford Ladies Golf Club have decided to support this year is Alzheimer Scotland and Beach Wheelchairs. There will be small competitions available to enter on the day eg. no of balls in jar, guess the golf course etc where we would appreciate your support.**

1. Open to all lady golfers who hold a current WHS handicap with a max HI of 36. Those with a higher HI may enter but play to a max HI of 36.
2. Application shall be in writing, accompanied by the specified non-refundable entry fee or by email with Bank transfer of entry fee (Code 800823 A/C No 00398922).
3. Times shall be allocated on a first-come basis and notified by email or text. The draw will be made on Friday 4th June.
4. Competitors must register at least 15 minutes prior to play. Handicap certificates or CDH ID number are required.
5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the current Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and any additional Local Rules as stated by Gifford Golf Club.
6. 18 holes of stroke play shall be played. Prizes will be awarded for best nett team.
7. Ladies shall play from the Red Medal Tees.
8. Ties shall be decided by card count-back over the last 9, 6, 3, or 1 hole(s), using appropriate handicap fractions; if there is still a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place, the prizes will be shared.
9. Handicap prizes shall take precedence over scratch prizes. No competitor may win more than one prize, excluding smaller prizes such as 'nearest the hole'.
10. Competitors shall walk at all times during the competition unless permitted to use transportation by the Committee, as provided for in terms of the Club Transportation Policy.
11. Devices that measure **distance only** shall be permitted.
12. In the event of dangerous weather conditions, Rule 5-7, Rules of Golf applies.
13. If the competition requires to be abandoned, no prizes will be awarded.
14. If the money from any '2's sweep is not awarded, it will be donated to the charity.
15. The Committee reserves the right to amend start times if necessary, and in all other matters its decision will be final.
